Duties include performing in costume, greeting guests, photo ops, and being part of our entertainment programs and other hosting duties as required. Dancing is a MUST.

Work Environment: Team Members will be in direct contact with Guests and must be friendly and outgoing. Good Customer Service and Customer Relations skills are required. Must be a Team Player

Physical Demands:

- Able to perform both indoors and outdoors in full costume.
- Work effectively in a hot and claustrophobic costume environment
- Able to perform in a costume weighing approximately 50lbs for 30-45 minutes at a time
- Able to lift and carry 50lbs without assistance
- Frequently required to walk, stand for long periods of time, balance, stoop, kneel, sit/stand repeatedly or crouch
- Must be able to work within the costume and utilize auditory cues from other employees to "see" and navigate through crowds

Must be at least 16 years of age

Experience with point of sales systems and cash handling an asset

Available to work weekends, holidays, and flexible hours as required by park operating schedule

Attention to detail, and exceptional customer service skills

Due to the nature of the costume, candidates may be required to possess certain physical attributes (ie. Height and weight) to ensure a good fit

Must be able to pass a criminal background check
