DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Rapidly assess and prioritize medical emergencies based on severity and criticality.
- Administer immediate appropriate scope of practice medical care to individuals experiencing injuries, illness, or trauma.
- Perform triage to identify and categorize patients based on the severity of their conditions.
- Effectively communicate with emergency services and provide accurate and concise information for seamless coordination.
- Administer basic life support measures, including CPR and defibrillation, when required.
- Maintain thorough and accurate documentation of patient assessments, interventions, and medical history.
- Ongoing training and drills to enhance emergency response capabilities.
- Adhere to ethical and legal standards while respecting patient confidentiality and privacy.
- Maintain and check emergency medical equipment and supplies daily, prior to each shift to ensure operational readiness.
- Collaborate with regional police, paramedics and fire services when required.

KNOWLEDGE & ABILITIES

- In-depth knowledge of emergency medical procedures, protocols, and best practices.
- Understanding of pharmacology and the administration of medications in emergency situations.
- Knowledge of the operation and maintenance of emergency medical equipment and devices.
- Rapid decision-making and critical thinking skills in high-pressure situations.
- Effective communication skills, both verbal and written, to convey information clearly and concisely.
- Strong interpersonal skills to interact compassionately with patients, families, and other healthcare professionals.
- Successful candidates will be comfortable using a handheld two-way radio, as part of their daily uniform.
- Excellent organizational skills to manage resources, time, and priorities effectively.
- Knowledge of the Mental Health Act.
- Knowledge of PHIPA.
- Knowledge of the Health Care Consent Act.
- Must be able to lift weights in excess of 150lbs on a spinal board with a partner.
- Ability to work in confined spaces.
- Must be able to sit, stand, and walk for long periods of time throughout the day/night.

- Must be able to operate computer patient care systems for documentation purposes.
